Jefferson Starship to Headline Museum Anniversary Concert

The 25th Anniversary Celebration and 6th National Corvette Caravan just got a little cooler as the event will officially kick off with a concert and fireworks show featuring Jefferson Starship on Thursday, August 29, 2019 at the Museum's Ampitheater.

Hits of the band include Miracles, Somebody to Love, Volunteers, Jane, White Rabbit, We Built This City and

more. The band features original and historic members David Freiberg and drummer Donny Baldwin, along with longtime members Chris Smith on keyboards and synth bass, Jude Gold on lead guitar and GRAMMY Nominee Cathy Richardson anchoring the female lead vocal spot made famous by the inimitable Grace Slick (who invited her to sing in her place as Jefferson Airplane accepted their Lifetime Achievement Award at the GRAMMY Merit Awards Concert).

arriving at the Museum. This will help the registration lines be much shorter as only those not traveling with a caravan, or those registering on site will need to visit the registration area at the Museum.
